

## Information Clause for persons specified in the agreement

Pursuant to art. 14 of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016 (Official Journal of the EU L 119 of 04/05/2016), please be advised that:

- 1) The Controller of your personal data is:

- 2) Your personal data has been obtained from a contractor who designated you as a contact person for the purposes of handling an agreement concluded with the Controller. The personal data which has been provided includes: name and surname, position or function as well as business contact details (e.g. e-mail address, telephone number).
- 3) Your personal data shall be processed for the purposes of the performance of the agreement, based on the legally justified interest of the controller pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 item f) of the General Data Protection Regulation, for the duration of the agreement and thereafter until the expiry of the periods of limitation for claims.  
The controller's legally justified interest is to enable any communication related to the conclusion and performance of the subject of the agreement, receiving and transmitting the declarations of will of the parties to the agreement, forwarding any possible complaints and claims, and upon termination of the agreement, the necessity to establish, assert or defend against any potential claims.
- 4) The recipients of your personal data will be entities entitled to obtain personal data, entities involved in the performance of the agreement, banks, providers of IT solutions, the accounting office, law firms, insurance companies, post offices, shipping companies, entities belonging to the Star Polska group, and in particular Star S.P.A Loc. II Moro 1 20085 Locate di Triulzi – Italy, Star Internationale Transporte Deutschland GmbH, Heegstrasse 26, 45356 Essen – Germany.
- 5) Your personal data shall be stored for the duration of the agreement and for the period specified in applicable legal provisions or based on the legally justified interest pursued by the controller (the data shall be processed until such time as the processing for business planning purposes ceases).
- 6) You hold the right to request from the controller access to your personal data, its rectification, erasure or restriction of processing as well as the right to lodge an objection.
- 7) You hold the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
- 8) Providing personal data is voluntary, however, refusal to provide such data may result in refusal to conclude an agreement.
